B: DENLEYS

Open-plan wine bar style. Beer: Otter Ale, Otter Bright, nicely kept; Cobra, etc. Award-winning Essence of India restaurant (formerly Saffron) at rear; also Indian bar snacks. Friday live music. denleysessenceofindia.co.uk



C: DRAKES WINE & ALE HOUSE

Very popular, friendly (and often very crowded) 'mixers' pub. Home-cooked lunches 11am-2.30pm. Live acoustic music Fridays from 9 (open to 12). Beer: excellent real ales. Otter, London Pride, alongside a good general range. drakesoftopsham.co.uk



D: THE EXETER

A friendly modern styled locals' pub Darts and pool. Apart from regular Teignworthy Beachcomber is regular, with 2/3 others always on, in an excellent and changing selection - and since 2008 the Exeter has had a well-deserved entry in the Good Beer Guide. Games: Pool, darts, games

E: THE GLOBE

Very nice traditional coaching inn. CAMRA recommended (Doom Bar, Otter Amber, Tribute, guest beers). Restaurant and table snacks. Folk Club on Sundays, check website for other musical events. Open to midnight Fri/Sat. globehotel.com

Very popular spacious pub on Topsham Quay. Lunch/evening meals/sandwiches served at tables. Outside seating on quay. Good beer range from Badger: Best, Tanglefoot, Lemony Cricket.

H: THE PASSAGE

Friendly pub and restaurant by Exe, encouraging both drinkers and diners, street and riverside patio seating too. Real ales straight from the barrel: Otter, London Pride, etc. Varied English/ Continental menu, local fish a speciality.



I: ROUTE 2

Previously the Steam Packet, reopened after renovation. Open 8am-8pm as a licensed cafe bar serving breakfast, teas and coffees, a variety of freshly-cooked modern-style food (e.g.pizzas, toasted bagels), homemade ice-cream, draught Doom Bar and various lagers and wines. Live musical events.



J: TOPSHAM WINE CELLAR

Continental-style vineyard wine cellar bar. Serves wines (Pebblebed, other Devon and selected imported), local beer and imported lager. Food: "local tapas" platters of meats, cheese, pate and fish.

Open Wed-Saturday 5:30-9:30pm, Saturday 11am-2:30pm, or by arrangement. Large groups welcome (up to 40) but call to reserve. pebblebed.co.uk
